**DE GRUYTER EVIDENCE BASED ACQUISITION – FREEDOM
FOR LIBRARIES**

At De Gruyter an increasing amount of our eBooks business is done via EBA. We have been offering EBA for over 4 years now and therefore we have finely tuned back office systems/work flows in place to support this type of acquisition. Our model is relatively flexible in terms of the content segments available and EBA period. EBA model can start any time, and is not connected with calendar year. De Gruyter's Evidence Based Acquisition Model provides libraries with a flexible approach to eBook purchasing. Under this EBA model, institutions are given access to All De Gruyter eBooks including our Partner Press content (Harvard University Press, Princeton University Press, Cornell University Press etc. – 14 in total) – altogether ca 60.000 ebooks.

During the workshop I am going to present the offer, and focus on how to get the best value out of the offer. I.e. will demonstrate the combination of De Gruyter and Princeton University Press offer on mathematics, or De Gruyter + University of Pennsylvania Press + Harvard University Press + Cornell University Press resources on European History etc.
